Medication Policy Reminder

Updated medication forms are found under the Policies section on our website. Your child may not have medication on their person (including an inhaler) without submitting these important forms.

Student Attire

Please review the following policy information regarding student clothing. All guidelines apply to both male and female students. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be no more than 3 inches above the top of the knee cap. Shirts and tops must cover the shoulders; no tank tops or shirts with armholes open below the armpit area. Tops must have a neckline higher than the straight line from underarm to underarm and must reach below the belt-line to cover the stomach. Tops must conceal undergarments (no sheer or see-through portions that don't meet the previous criteria). These guidelines apply to all students, K-12. Thank you for reviewing your student's attire before they come to school each day to ensure it meets these standards.
