April 10th Sign up Deadline for Liberty, Victory & Legacy Annual Lotteries – If you know of parents/guardians interested in signing up their children for the Harbor Schools' annual lotteries, please share with them that the deadline to do so is April 10. They can do so either by completing the lottery form at each school during school hours, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday-Friday, or by going to each school's website and following the instructions for submitting online, by email, or fax. Instructions in Spanish are also available online, and if an interpreter is needed to assist in completing the lottery forms either over the phone or at the school, one will be provided. The schools will hold their lotteries on the following dates at 3 pm at their school: Liberty-April 17; Victory-April 18; Legacy-April 19. Each school's lottery will determine its 2018-2019 waiting list. [2nd Notice]

New Homelessness Response System for Idaho -- As of Jan. 2018, Idaho has a new standardized approach to homelessness response to address the needs of those experiencing a housing crisis, to help them gain access to programs & services, and to ensure those experiencing or at risk of homelessness that are seeking long-term housing solutions have consistent access to housing resources. In particular, individuals in need of housing assistance now have one, regional access point to work with -- for the Nampa area this is the Salvation Army, [403 12th Ave S, Nampa](#), [208-467-6586](#). Those in need of immediate shelter should continue to access emergency shelters, such as Nampa's Valley Women & Children's Shelter, 475-0725; and Lighthouse Men's Shelter, 461-5030. The school's homeless liaison is also available to assist in sharing & coordinating these resources.

Wellness Policy

Our stakeholders, as part of the Wellness Policy requirements (Policy 8200), may participate in the policy's review, update, and implementation. Comments will be shared with the federal programs coordinator, administrator, and governing board when they conduct policy reviews. Our school has implemented the model policy as set forth by the Idaho School Board Association (ISBA) to ensure we comply with state statute and federal regulations, while adhering to the Harbor School Method as set forth in our charter and certificate, and so that our policy compares favorably with school districts statewide. It is the intention of the school's administration and governing board to attain the goals included in this policy and to be in compliance. An annual assessment is conducted by the school's wellness committee, which consists of an administrator, the food services director, the federal programs coordinator, PE teacher, and others as requested, and takes into account stakeholder feedback and governing board direction if/when provided.
