If your son/daughter needs to take a summer recovery course, please go to IDLA.org to register for an online recovery course.

The following are the steps you will need to take to register a recovery course online through IDLA. You can wait until after final grades post.

1. Go to <https://register.idla.us/>. Use the pass code TW82D. An email will then be sent to me to confirm the class.
2. After confirmation you will go back in and pay for the class. Money will no longer be handled through Victory.
3. The cost is \$75 per class. You will only have from today through June 30th to sign up for Flex classes that started 6-4-17 .
