

VICTORY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL Parent Notifications – Federal Programs – August 24, 2018

Regarding Right to Receive Teacher Information:

Federal law requires that each school district receiving Title 1 funds notify parents of each student attending any school receiving these funds that information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher(s) may be requested. As a parent of a student attending a school receiving federal program funds, you have the right to know: Is my child's teacher licensed to teach the grades and subject(s) assigned? Is my child's teacher teaching with a provisional license, meaning the state has waived requirements for my child's teacher? What is the college major of my child's teacher? What degree or degrees does my child's teacher hold? If there are instructional aides working with my child, what are their qualifications? If my child is or will be taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks this year by a teacher who is not highly qualified, will I be notified in a timely manner? To request the state qualifications for your child's teacher or instructional aide, contact the school at 208-442-9400.

School Annual Report Card & Charter Commission Annual Report: Over Victory's history, and no matter the assessments or reviews conducted, the school has continuously outperformed State academic outcomes, as well as nearby district outcomes, while achieving 100% graduation rates. There, you will be connected to the SDE website for the school's outcomes. Additionally, charter schools authorized by the Idaho Public Charter School Commission receive an Annual Report from the Commission that's available to the public in which a school's academic outcomes, operations & finances are rated. Victory has received "Honor" standing in all three areas – the highest rating attainable, and is up this year for automatic renewal of its five-year certificate with the Charter Commission as a result of its academic, operations and financial success. Victory's full reports can be found on our website under About Us, and then on School Report Card. Additionally, this August, the Idaho State Dept. of Education named Victory one of Idaho's top-performing high schools and one of its "Goal-Maker" high schools.
